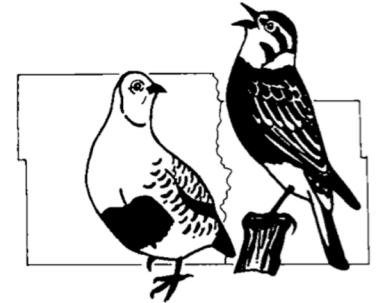

### Abundance Code:

(A)=abundant, present in large numbers.

(C)=common, present in good numbers, always seen in appropriate habitat.

(FC)=fairly common, present in smaller numbers, not always seen.

(U)=uncommon, present in low numbers, seldom seen.

(R)=rare, a surprise appearance.

(Acc)=accidental, seen less than five times.

\* Breeding reported within Cass-Clay.

\*Note: Sightings of warblers and shorebirds in “summer” are not unexpected given our nearness to warbler nesting areas and the protracted seasonal migrations of shorebirds.

+Note: Almost any waterfowl species can be expected to be wintering near the north Moorhead lagoon area.
